




Hello from Edmonton. I hope you are doing well in these winter months. I am thankful for you and your ministry. Let's pray for one another as we seek to lead our people into deeper connection with Christ.

I recently read a book on prayer. I know we believe in prayer and I trust that this is one

spiritual discipline you will never neglect. But this older book, "The Hidden Life of Prayer" by David McIntyre, emphasized the battle won through prayer over our flesh and in the heavenly realm. "Sometimes we are conscious of a satanic impulse directed immediately against the life of prayer in our souls; sometimes we are led into 'aridities' and wilderness experiences, and the face of God grows dark above us; sometimes, when we strive most earnestly to bring every thought and imagination under obedience to Christ, we seem to be given over to disorder and unrest; sometimes the inbred slothfulness of our nature lends itself to the evil one as an instrument by which he may turn our minds back from the exercise of prayer. Because of all these things. therefore, we must be diligent and resolved, watching as a sentry who remembers that the lives of men are lying at the hazard of his wakefulness, resourcefulness and courage. 'And I say unto you,' said the Lord to his disciples, 'I say to all, Watch!""
