Celebration 2019 was earlier this month in Banff, Alberta. We had a very good meeting

with just under 100 delegates from six provinces. Our theme was: "BGC is Better Together" and we started the Conference by asking two questions:

Family issues have affected me this month as well. My dear mother went home to be with the Lord on June 6. She was 98 and had been suffering from dementia for the last six years. At 4:30 am the night staff in her nursing home heard her singing in her bed and then at 5 when they checked again she was gone. I like to think she had some clarity in those last moments and sang her way into the Lord's presence. Also, my wife's sister in Arkansas has been diagnosed with Stage 4 cancer. She has had one surgery but they did not get all of the cancer. She is to begin chemo but the disease is very advanced. We need God's healing touch. She is a strong believer but this is a shock to us, especially my wife. Please pray for us as we grieve my mother and pray with anticipation for Laura's sister.




